Safety Rules: Circular Saws and Electric Planers

## **Purpose**

This document outlines the rules for the safe operation of circular saws and electric planers.

### Scope

This document applies to all authorised maintenance workers, deemed competent by their supervisor.

## Training

Supervisors shall arrange for maintenance workers to be trained in the safe and correct operation by a person experienced in circular saw / electric planer usage (as appropriate) and with reference to the Manufacturer's Instruction booklet.

#### **Procedure**

- Operators must follow the operating procedures outlined in the Manufacturer's information booklet. The Manufacturer's Instructions must be kept with the equipment.
- 2. Guards must be fitted and in good working order and used for the purpose they are intended.
- 3. PPE to be worn: Safety glasses or full-face shield, safety boots, hearing protection.
- 4. Ensure no hair or loose clothing can get near the work surface
- 5. Always use a sharp blade or knives
- 6. Always disconnect from power supply when adjusting / maintaining the saw
- 7. Always isolate from power supply when maintaining planer
- 8. Always ensure work surface is secure and free from movement
- 9. Always check for obstacles, nails etc before cutting / planning
- 10. Use appropriate manual handling techniques do not bend and twist the back, use the legs. Take regular rest breaks. Remember, vibration can also cause manual handling injuries.
