Safety Rules: High Pressure Cleaner

Purpose

This document outlines the rules for the safe operation of high pressure cleaners.

Scope

This document applies to all ground/maintenance workers required to use high pressure cleaners.

Training

Supervisors shall arrange for workers to be trained in the safe and correct operation by a person experienced in usage of high pressure cleaning equipment and with reference to the Manufacturer's Instruction booklet.

Rules

- 1. PPE to be worn: Footwear enclosing the foot to ankle height with sturdy soles, ear plugs, protective glasses or face shield
- 2. Operators must follow the operating procedures outlined in the Manufacturer's information booklet.
- 3. The operator must ensure there are no persons or public property that may be hit by flying debris.
- 4. Operator to inspect area to be cleared and if required the work area must be cordoned off and members of the public kept clear.
- 5. A First Aid kit should be kept in close proximity of operations.
