



Safety Rules: High Pressure Cleaner

Purpose

This document outlines the rules for the safe operation of high pressure cleaners.

Scope

This document applies to all ground/maintenance workers required to use high pressure cleaners.

Training

Supervisors shall arrange for workers to be trained in the safe and correct operation by a person experienced in usage of high pressure cleaning equipment and with reference to the Manufacturer's Instruction booklet.

Rules

1. PPE to be worn: Footwear enclosing the foot to ankle height with sturdy soles, ear plugs, protective glasses or face shield
2. Operators must follow the operating procedures outlined in the Manufacturer's information booklet.
3. The operator must ensure there are no persons or public property that may be hit by flying debris.
4. Operator to inspect area to be cleared and if required the work area must be cordoned off and members of the public kept clear.
5. A First Aid kit should be kept in close proximity of operations.
